## Outline

The SWL Major Trauma Network are pleased to share with you a case study of an individual who sustained complex musculo skeletal injuries. His story includes an intensive care stay, numerous complex skeletal injuries, a stroke, periods of non-weight bearing and high-level rehabilitation needs.

We shall focus on his journey, ward transitions, inter-disciplinary communication, and ultimately what can be delivered for patients with complex musculoskeletal rehabilitation needs. We shall explore how timing, intensity and dose of rehabilitation can facilitate improved recovery times, function and reduce the possible presentation of anxiety and depression associated with limited physical function and delayed access to rehabilitation.

We hope to facilitate discussion and interaction about current service delivery and how we have collaborated positively with the legal and private sector services.
